PLEASE REMEMBER ...

At least one certified teacher must come with the students. We encourage you to have a chaperone for every ten students. There will also be at least one member of the Historical Society on site to assist you.

Chaperons are asked not to bring preschoolers along with their child's classroom.

Visitor parents should only come at designated times determined by the classroom teacher.

Adults may use cameras before and/or after the formal lessons.

We have a telephone landline but please bring cell phones with you.

Students should arrive and depart by the school bus.

A basic emergency kit is located in the office.

There is an indoor washroom that can be used by one student at a time. There are also outdoor washrooms provided by the Forest Preserve. We encourage the use of these washrooms because they are more representative of a one-room schoolhouse. We reserve the indoor washroom for emergencies.

The Forest Preserve does have a pavilion that can be used for lunchtime, if you desire. Picnic tables are located in this area. We suggest that you have the students bring a bottled water.

We do use public school approved cleaning supplies.

Inform the Historical Society prior to visit of any child with special needs.

Students and teachers are encouraged to dress in the clothing typical of the 1930's. See enclosed sheets on dress options.
